### **ARMING & DISARMING**

To Arm System in **Stay** mode, press **and hold** the **STAY** button. (motion detector(s) will be bypassed) To Arm System in **Away** mode, press **and hold** the **AWAY** button. (motion detector(s) will be on)

To Disarm System, enter your 4-digit user code.



# **MEMORY**



To View Memory, press \* 3 The zone that tripped the alarm will be displayed.

To Clear Memory, arm your system.

Close all zones to get green system "Ready" light. (see zone listing above)

Now you can arm the system.
