ARMING & DISARMING


To Arm System in Stay mode, press and hold the STAY button. (motion detector(s) will be bypassed)

To Arm System in **Away** mode, press and hold the AWAY button. (motion detector(s) will be on)


To Disarm System, enter your 4-digit user code.

Press (*)







To view Trouble Condition, press (*) (2)






- Loss of AC power (possibly due to power outage, breaker tripped or transformer unplugged)

To Clear Memory, arm your system.
